A planned gift will protect

AGE's future as it will allow the organization to continue evolving and growing to meet the needs of the aging community in Central Texas.

Unrestricted planned gifts will be used to fuel sustainability funds that can be drawn upon in times of financial need. The financial stability that these funds create will serve as a safeguard for AGE's services while also increasing AGE's chances at receiving significant investments from local funders. Restricted funding, when possible, will support the program or initiative of your choice.

AGE has big plans for the future and we'd love for <u>YOU</u> to be a part of them!

AGE is expanding to South Austin to better serve the rapidly growing number of older adults and caregivers in need. In September 2019, AGE purchased the land for this building and has worked with a team of architects and AGE staff members to design a state of the art facility that will be specially equipped to provide compassionate and individualized care for older adults with cognitive or physical challenges as well as their caregivers.

Choose How to Tell Your Story

You, as the donor can plan now and choose to give <u>now</u> or give <u>later</u>. What do we mean by this?

Gifts such as bequests, retirement plans, and life insurance are <u>planned for now, and then</u> <u>distributed to AGE upon your passing</u>. This is one of the most meaningful ways for you to leave your legacy while creating a future for older adults and their caregivers to thrive.

Gifts of cash, personal property, real estate and/or mineral rights, qualified charitable distributions, appreciated securities, and gifts given through a donor-advised fund <u>can all be given now</u> to have an immediate impact on older adults and caregivers in Central Texas. If you, as the donor so choose, these gifts <u>can also be given after your passing</u>.

To choose the gift that matches your philanthropic goals you should consider when you want your gift to be distributed to AGE, and what types of tax benefits you want to receive. Planned giving can provide relief and/or benefits on income tax, estate tax, and capital gains tax. To help you and your family match your gift to your goals, please use our guide on the following two pages.

Bequests

Name AGE in your will, trust or other estate plan document. This can be specified as a dollar amount or estate percentage. Sample will language available at the end of this guide.

Retirement Plans

Name AGE as a beneficiary to your IRA, 401(K), 403(B), pension, or other tax-deferred plan. This is a simple way to make a gift upon your death and can provide tax benefits as well

Life Insurance

Name AGE as a beneficiary of your life insurance policy and the death benefit will pass to AGE upon your passing.



Reduce Estate Tax

Gifts that you can plan for now and will be distributed to AGE now or later.



Appreciated Securities

Giving securities, including stocks and bonds, and mutual funds is easy and effective. A gift of appreciated securities to AGE can provide a tax deduction and help avoid capital gains tax. Recipient broker account information available upon request.

Gift of Personal Property

Make a gift of an asset no longer needed and generate an income tax deduction. Ex. Artwork, jewelry or cars.

Gift of Real Estate and/or Mineral Interests

Give your home, ranch, vacation property, commercial property or vacant lot. If your property has appreciated, giving it to AGE can provide a tax deduction and help avoid capital gains tax.

Qualified Charitable Distribution (IRA Rollover)

Give a tax-free IRA charitable rollover without being subject to income taxes on the required minimum distribution. You must be 70 and a half years or older.

Donor Advised Fund

Give through a donor advised fund to make a charitable contribution, and then recommend donations to AGE from the fund over time.

Giving cash is simple and the most basic way to make a difference at AGE. Set up a recurring gift to be paid monthly or quarterly as an easy way to maximize your income tax relief while increasing your impact.
